## 2012 BMWBMW SRR – Dave Keuch Memorial Loop (via Gettysburg)

## Notes:

All roads are paved, and the length is about 78 miles. Riding time, without stops, is about 2.5-3 hours. Mileage is pretty accurate, but not guaranteed. Reset your Odometer to 0.0

I did not know Dave Keuch. But Don Graling did. Here's what he wrote:

"Dave was a BMWBMW club member who was killed in a motorcycle accident in Bethesda in October 1996. A car pulled out of an office building parking lot and he t-boned the car and was pronounced dead at the scene. The driver was charged but not convicted. He was on a BMW K-1 at the time That previous August, Dave, Bob Ryun and I completed the SCMA Four Corners ride in 10,000 miles in 15 days. I was celebrating my 40th birthday. He was a great guy and well-liked by the entire club. Dave's wife Carol still lives in their home in Comus, MD and sometimes attends the rallies. She never remarried. Ted and Dave used to ride the route during the week and call me at work to harass me on a beautiful day. It was pure torture."

I have slightly modified the route I was initially given. The directions were poorly written in the Ft. Ritchie area and we don't want **you** getting lost.

Almost all of the ride is on 2 lane roads, most of which are defined by Jim Ford of The Rider's Workshop as "invisible roads". They are definitely straighter than the other 2 loops, and tend to be of low traffic volume with fewer elevation changes—but it's still a nice ride.

This route leaves West-Mar and proceeds northeast past Ft. Ritchie on the MD-PA border. For more detailed information on Ft. Ritchie's history, see: http://www.fortritchie.com/index.php?src=gendocs&ref=History

A considerable amount of the 1<sup>st</sup> part of the ride in PA passes through the Michaux Forest. After crossing US 30, you will pass through the Caledonia State Park on Pine Grove Rd. Continuing northeasterly, you'll pass the now-empty Chambersburg Reservoir. Turning right on Shippensburg Rd will carry you over a ridge that, while mostly straight is entertaining. Eventually you will turn south onto PA 34, which is almost a straight shot, south, into Gettysburg. Famous for the Civil War battle (the War Between The States, as Southerners like to call it) which took place nearby, Gettysburg is filled with lots of galleries, shops, restaurants and other "touristy" places. Of course, there is also the Battlefield park to tour if you're of a mind. Stop at the Visitor's center (http://www.nps.gov/gett/index.htm) to find out what, where, and how.

These modified directions keep you off US 15, a four lane divided highway with at-grade intersections. Therefore the return route continues on 2-lane roads. Once you re-enter MD and have turned onto Foxville-Deerfield Rd and passed Manahan Rd (on the left) know that you'll pass within about a mile of Camp David—the President's Catoctin Mountain Retreat—but even if you know where it is, you'll likely never see it.

Ride carefully, and enjoy.
